

5-Hour Tour Isla Lobos in San Cristobal Island (Shared tour)



The main **sea-lion and blue-footed booby** colonies. Lobos Island is a small Island outside of San Cristobal. Snorkel with sea lions, marine iguanas, and colorful fish. Spot blue-footed boobies and other nesting seabirds. Climb to the top of the island for stunning views.

It is a trip of approximately 35 minutes, you arrive at the Island, disembark with the Naturalist Guide, he takes you along the path that surrounds this small volcanic formation, it is very likely to find blue-footed boobies on the trail, frigate birds and sea lions. After finishing the trail, they return to the boat to snorkel on the shore of this small Island. Then, we go to Ochoa beach, which is in front of this Island. There it is time to relax on the beach.

This tour would have to confirm availability since they leave with a minimum of 12 on the boat. There are two departures, one in the morning 7:45 a.m. and the other one in the afternoon 12:45 p.m.



The tour includes:

Box lunch, soft drinks, snorkeling equipment, towel, Naturalist Guide (English/Spanish – speaking).

The tour does not Include:

Travel insurance, optional activities, personal expenses, tips, wetsuit.
