

MIDDLE OF THE WORLD + TRANSFER OUT AIRPORT



On your last day in Quito, a tour you must do is The Middle of the World, to learn more about the equatorial line, its importance for indigenous peoples, its true location and the ancient sites that are still present near this enigmatic place.

At the end of the tour you will have the opportunity to be transferred at airport of Quito to continue your trip.

Itinerary:

In the morning pick up from your hotel in Quito or airport. Then, we drive to San Antonio Parish Town of Pichincha Province.

Visit to the Pululahua Crater:

Short hiking around the view point to observe the old inhabited caldera, setup 2500 years ago. We are in the middle of a sunk volcano. The vegetation is also possible to observe from the natural trail.

Intiñan Museum:

Visit one of the best museums in relation to the equatorial line. Do different experiments, such as balance an egg over a nail. See the Coriolis effect in the equator. And, bring a wide vision about the Ecuadorean indigenous people.

Middle of the world city:

The concept of this place is the same as the previous museum, only the focus changes, to talk about another part of the history that happened here, and is related to the first French Geodesic Mission who visited Ecuador in 1736.

Quito airport:

You will be drop-off at the airport of Quito in a 50-minute drive approximately. It relies on traffic.

The tour includes:

Guide/driver (English-speaking)

Comfortable transportation to or from the Middle of the World.
