

5-Hour Sierra Negra Volcano Tour



The second **largest volcanic caldera** in the world. Sierra Negra volcano in Isabela Galapagos. You can see the rocks formed by lava flows and volcanic fumaroles. It is considered one of **the best places for hiking in South America**. The Sierra Negra volcano has a height of 1,124 msl / 3,687 feet. It is one of the **most active volcano** with an age of 535,000 years. Its **last eruption** was in June 2018.

Itinerary:

Departure time is at 07:30 a.m. Please, go to the **meeting point** indicated by our Travel Agent, where the Guide and a vehicle will be waiting for you and will take you to the slopes of the Sierra Negra volcano. A Guide will take you walking along several volcanic rock paths, the terrain is generally flat and has few high mountains.

When you reach the top of the Sierra Negra Volcano you will be able to see the 10km (32,808 feet) diameter that is covered in solidified lava. The Guide will take you on a short walk to appreciate it better. The walk is long, we will make a stop where you will serve the snack they gave you at the beginning of the tour. It is advisable to bring **enough water for the hike**.
