

2-Day Puyo + Baños Waterfall and Amazon Route



Spectacular landscapes in the upper part of the **Amazon Rainforest**. **Hiking, birdwatching, waterfalls, ancestral trails** and more in this trip. **Impressive vegetation, fauna, rivers** and many more fascinating places. **Dramatic volcanic depressions**. Appropriate trip to go to the **Baños adventure city in Ecuador** and have the first contact with the **Amazon rainforest**.

Itinerary:

Day 1: Waterfall exploration day:

Departure 8:30 a.m. from the **meeting point in Baños city**. On the route we will visit to the “La Virgen”, the “Agoyan” waterfalls, walk through heaven's door, practice canopy and/or bungee jumping. Visit to the “Manto de la Novia” waterfall. Hike to the “Devil’s Cauldron” waterfall and hike to the “Machay” waterfall.

Return to the city of Baños in the afternoon. 30-minute drive by vehicle to reach the “Runtún” hamlet. Walk to the “Tree House”. Visit to the “Manos de la Pachamama” viewpoint. Return to the hotel in Baños. Enjoy the night life in the city.

Day 2: Nice time in the Amazon rain forest.

We meet in Baños city at 8:30 a.m. To start our travel by private car to Puyo, where we will visit a zoo where you can see animals from the Amazon, including monkeys, ocelots, and caimans. Then we will visit a beautiful waterfall, which is about two hours from the cabins. We can swim and enjoy the tranquility of the forest. The stunning surroundings make the area memorable.

On the way back to a camp through the jungle, we will have some explanations about the rainforest and its flora and fauna. We arrive at the camp we will have a traditional lunch. After that, we will do a rowing canoe ride for 30 minutes along the Puyo River, then we will visit a viewpoint where we will have an exceptional view of the tropical jungle.

We will continue our trip and visit a Kichwa indigenous community where you can observe how they make necklaces and bracelets. We can also practice the blowtorch and paint our faces with annatto, which is a natural vegetal pigment.

The adventure ends about 8:00 p.m. We can also visit a local family, where we can learn how to make artisanal chocolate. After this incredible adventure, we will return to Baños city.

The tour includes:
