

Full City Tour + Middle of the World + Cable Car



Your feet in both hemispheres. The center of the earth where the sun rises naked. The sun burns especially at midday. **Place an egg on the head of a nail.** You **lose weight** without much effort in the center of gravity of the earth. **The Coriolis effect at the equator line.** Intense solar radiation in the **Middle of the World.** Ways of living in the indigenous period. **Explore Intiñan Museum.**

See the city from the sky in the Cable Car or **TeleferiQo of Quito.** This tram was built in 2005 by French engineers, giving the city a touch of **technology and modernity.** **The cable car tops out at 4,050 msl / 10,000 feet.**

Itinerary:



Climbing up to the sky: (2,800 msl / 9,186 feet)

You will be picked-up from the hotel. The first visit is in the morning to get the cable car, after 20-minute ride in the cabin, we get off from it to do a hike in the mountains until to arrive in a swing of the clouds. Usually, from this point, we have a mesmerizing view of the Quito city. Good place to take pictures or just enjoy nature on the western Andes. The entire Avenue of the Volcanoes can be spotted from the highs, especial in the months from July and September.



Jump up on the equator line: (2,439 msl / 8,001 feet)

The second point of visit is the Equator Line in the famous Intiñan museum. Built in 1989, around a couple of centuries-old huts, and as a way to rescue the culture of the equinoctial peoples and the Lulumbamba indigenous people (San Antonio de Pichincha).

In addition, to get information the equatorial line, you can see and perform experiments that demonstrate how the earth's forces work on the center of the earth, such as the Coriolis effect.

Bring your passport to be stamped with the symbol of the middle of the world.



Walking tour in the old town of Quito:

At this point of the day, it is important to do a lunch break in one of the popular restaurants by the Plaza Grande. You can try a special locro de papas (potato soup) one of the popular dishes in Quito. After this, we can continue our tour to learn more about the first UNESCO city in the World, declared in 1978.

We will walk through the Plaza Grande, the Church of El Sagrario, the Street of the 7 Crosses, we will enter in the Church of the Company of Jesus, we will go up to the Plaza de San Francisco and finally, we will pass through the traditional Ronda street.
